#### **Mourning for Pope Francis-Reflection**

The Risen Jesus greets the disciples with wishes of peace on three occasions in the one day, according to John. The power to forgive is granted to them in their reception of the Holy Spirit. Pope Francis in Evangelii Gaudium (2013) wrote: "Let me say this once more: God never tires of forgiving us; we are the ones who tire of seeking his mercy ... Time and time again he bears us on his shoulders. No one can strip us of the dignity bestowed upon us by this boundless and unfailing love." This continuous affirmation of God's forgiveness has been a hallmark of this Papacy.

The Jubilee of Mercy followed in 2015 with its many graces and encouraging words.

'From the heart of the Trinity, from the depths of the mystery of God, the great river of mercy wells up and overflows unceasingly. It is a spring that will never run dry, no matter how many people draw from it. Every time someone is in need, he or she can approach it, because the mercy of God never ends.' March For Life, organised by the Pro Life Campaign which will take place on Bank Holiday Monday, 5th May in Dublin city centre@ 2pm

This year, the event is being held to draw attention to the need to offer support to women in unplanned pregnancy and ensure that they are not kept in the dark about positive alternatives to abortion. At present, all roads seem to lead to abortion for any woman facing an unplanned pregnancy. For every six babies born in Ireland today, one baby has his or her life ended through abortion - a truly horrifying reality. Ireland's abortion rate has risen from 2,879 in 2018 to 10,033 in 2023, highlighting the total lack of resources and commitment to addressing women's needs.

By having a significant turnout at the March For Life, we will be in a much stronger position to push for changes at governmental level that focus on supporting women in unplanned pregnancy rather than promoting abortion.
