CHURCH NOTICES

On 3rd May, the government announced the roadmap for reopening society and lifting Covid 19 restrictions. According to these guidelines: All churches are closed until 20th July Phase 4, on 20th July states that 'Places of worship can be opened,' (including for Mass), 'with social distancing measures.' We are planning to open the churches for **private prayer** from **Mon**. 8th June on weekdays between 10 am-5 pm. Prior to the opening we need to clean the churches and to make them safe by implementing the HSE guidelines.

The Parish Office is closed. However you can contact the Parish Secretary by phoning the usual Parish Office number 059 86 38391 which is diverting to the Parish Secretary who is working from home. Or you can email the parish at @eircom.net Letters or correspondence can be posted into the Parochial House.

If you want Mass Intentions or anniversaries prayed for, you can contact the Parish Secretary. If you wish to have a Mass card for those who are deceased or a Mass bouquet for the living, we can arrange to post these out to you.

All those who had baptisms or weddings booked before this date have been contacted and these ceremonies have been postponed. Phase 5 on 10th August, will allow some larger social gatherings, such as weddings, to take place. These will be restricted to the risks involved.

All **First Holy Communions** have been postponed until after the summer holidays. A letter from the Parish Team has been sent out through the schools. If you are a parent or guardian of a child who was due to receive their First Holy Communion and did not receive this email from the school, please contact your school.

Funerals The current restrictions will remain in place. Funerals, including those who died Covid 19 positive, can hold a funeral Mass in church. Attendance at funerals is kept to a max of 10 people-and only members of the household, close family or close friends. Social distancing and hand hygiene guidelines are adhered to. Phase Two which is on 8th June, allows a slightly larger number of people to attend funerals. This number will be announced closer to 8th June. A moving tribute to the deceased

is when extended family, neighbours and friends line the route respecting social distancing. This is such a show of support to the family of the deceased.
