First Holy Communion 2020 postponed

All the First Holy Communion celebrations that were due to be celebrated in the Parishes of Athy, Narraghmore and Moone during the months of April and May will not go ahead on the dates planned. The First Holy Communion celebrations are postponed until after the summer holidays at least. This decision was made by the Parish Team in consultation with the School Principals. We are fully aware that this is very regrettable, especially for the children who were so looking forward to the celebration.

The First Holy Communion celebration will go ahead. When this will happen is currently out of our hands, as we are obliged to adhere to HSE guidelines for the health and safety of all concerned. When it is possible to hold gatherings again in our churches, the Parish Team intend to consult as much as possible with the schools and with the parents and, adhering to HSE guidelines, decide on when and how to proceed.

A letter from the Parish Team was sent out through the schools to all the parents/guardians of the children who will be making their First Holy Communion. If you have not received your letter, please contact your school.

We encourage all the children with their families to continue to pray and to prepare for First Holy Communion. At this time of the Coronavirus, prayer is immensely powerful, especially the prayers of children.


FR FRANK CAFFREY C.S.Sp RIP

Fr Frank Caffrey was a curate in the Parish of Athy from 1996 to 2003. He died in Kimmage Manor in Dublin on 14th April. Fr Frank was ordained a Holy Ghost Father in 1963. His first mission was to Nigeria where he experienced the ravages of the Civil War and the consequent famine in Biafra. He worked with colleagues in relief work until they were arrested, imprisoned, and deported. He was sent to Kenya where he was based in Mombasa, teaching, and serving nine outstations. After thirteen years of his mission in the Kenyan capital of Nairobi, for health reasons he returned to Ireland where a year later, in 1996 he appointed to the Parish of Athy. He is well remembered as a quiet, friendly good-natured priest. After seven years in Athy, he was appointed to Bayside Parish in North Dublin. He was later sent to the Spiritan Provincial House where he was the Bursar. He returned to Kimmage Manor where he lived until his death on 14th April. We pray for the repose of this soul and for his sisters, May and Rita, his brother Brendan, his extended family, and his Spiritan Community. May he rest in Peace
