Tap and Go Contactless Donation

A choice as to how you donate to the first (Common Fund for the support of priests) and second (**Share Fund** for support of poorer parishes) Collections



The Archdiocese of Dublin has introduced a "Tap and Go" contactless donation method to enable people to donate directly to the First Collection (Common Fund) and the Second Collection (Share Fund).

A card machine is in place in the main porch at the back of the Church for this purpose.

Please note any donation through this method will be split 60% to the First Collection and 40% to the Second Collection.

You can use your Debit/Credit Card or indeed your mobile phone if you it payments enabled on your phone.

Donations by this method will be anonymous for the time being.

Familiar collection 'buckets' and the current envelope system remain in place.

Donations in envelopes give additional financial benefit to the Diocese and the Parish in that they qualify under the charitable donations scheme for refund from Revenue

Feast Day of SS. Philip and James-May 3rd

Though there's not an especially important reason behind the unification of St. Philip and St. James' memorial, these apostles both shared lives radically devoted to the Gospel and paid the ultimate sacrifice for their faith. In the sixth century, the bodies of Sts. Philip and James were brought to Rome from the East and were laid to rest in the Basilica of the Holy Apostles. Since they arrived together at the same location, the Church instituted a single feast day for both apostles


