# **DOMINICAN MASS** today,

# St. Michael's Church, Athy, at 12 noon

Fr. John Harris, the provisional of the Dominican order, and Fr. John Walsh will celebrate Mass in St. Michael's Church, Athy, on 29th May, at 12 noon. During the Mass the Dominican Order will gift the Dominican Crucifix to the Parish of Athy.



The figure of Jesus on the cross was originally hanging in the former Dominican church, Athy.

It was stored in Dominican Priory, Tallaght, since the Dominican Church closed in Nov. 2015. We are very thankful to the Dominican Order for gifting the figure of Jesus. This figure was restored by Brid Ní Rinn who sculpted the original figure in the 1960's for the Dominican Church. She mounted the figure on the new cross. It is now handing in the apse behind the high altar. We welcome the figure of Jesus back home to Athy. We thank some of the Parishioners who covered the cost of restoration, mounting and lighting. We look forward to welcoming Fr. Harris and Fr Walsh to Athy. All are welcome to join in the celebration of the Mass



World Youth Day will take place 1-6 August in Lisbon 2023. Package options and costs are still being determined and the registration system will open in September. At present it is intended to have the option for teenagers aged 16-18 to participate as well as those aged 18-29.

This is a great opportunity to reach out to young people and connect them to young people in many parishes that will participate at WYD. A full pastoral programme for all pilgrims will also commence later in the year, with opportunities for leadership roles as well.
