



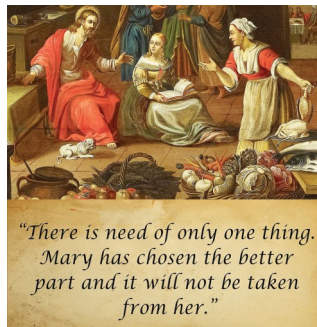

Tap and Go Contactless Donation

A choice as to how you donate



The Archdiocese of Dublin has introduced a "Tap and Go" contactless donation method to enable people to donate directly to the **First Collection (Common Fund Priest Collection)** and the **Second Collection (Share Fund)**.

Card machines are in place at the back of the Church for this purpose.

Please note any donation through this method will be split 60% to the Common Fund & 40% to Share Fund

You can use your Debit/Credit Card or indeed your mobile phone if you it payments enabled on your phone.

Donations by this method are anonymous for now.
Familiar collection bags and the current envelope system remain in place.

Train to Teach The Mindful Warrior Programme

This is an ONSITE Course

The Sanctuary is now offering a training course for those
who work with young people to enable them to deliver our
Mindful Warrior Programme in their own school or centre.
What is the Mindful Warrior?

The Warrior Programme is a teacher trainer programme
that draws on the various traditions of culture and the arts,
helping young people to end up as gentle warriors. It is
built around an initiation framework linked to adolescent
psychological development that includes:

**Inclusion of the Mindful Warrior Programme in the
classroom helps to transform young people's behaviour
and helps them to develop self-awareness and the
resilience needed to deal with challenges and
disappointments in life.**
