Tap and Go Contactless Donation

A choice as to how you donate



The Archdiocese of Dublin has introduced a "Tap and Go" contactless donation method to enable people to donate directly to the First Collection (Common Fund Priest Collection) and the Second Collection (Share Fund).

Card machines are in place at the back of the Church for this purpose.

Please note any donation through this method will be split 60% to the Common Fund & 40% to Share Fund

You can use your Debit/Credit Card or indeed your mobile phone if you it payments enabled on your phone. Donations by this method are anonymous for now. Familiar collection bags and the current envelope system remain in place.

Covid-19 RESTRICTIONS are now lifted



St Maria Goretti Feast Day: 6th July

October 16, 1890 - July 6, 1902) is an Italian virgin-martyr of the Catholic Church, and one of the youngest <u>saints</u> to be <u>canonized</u>. She was born to a farming family. Her father died when she was nine, and the family had to share a house with another family, the Serenellis. Maria took over household duties while her mother, brothers and sister worked in the fields. One afternoon, Alessandro, the Serenellis' twenty-year-old son, made

sexual advances to her. When she refused to submit to him, he stabbed her fourteen times. She was taken to the hospital but she died forgiving him. He was arrested, convicted and jailed. During imprisonment, he repented. After 27 years, he was released from prison and visited her mother to beg forgiveness, which she granted. He later became a <u>lay brother</u> monastery and died in 1970. She was beatified in 1947 and canonized in 1950. She is especially venerated in the Congregation of the Passion (Passionists).
