Tap and Go Contactless Donation



A choice as to how you donate

The Archdiocese of Dublin has introduced a
"Tap and Go" contactless donation method to enable people
to donate directly to the **First Collection (Common Fund
Priest Collection)** and the **Second Collection (Share Fund
Card machines** are in place at the back of the Church for
this purpose.

**Please note any donation through this method will be
split 60% to the Common Fund & 40% to Share Fund**
You can use your Debit/Credit Card or indeed your
mobile phone if you it payments enabled on your phone.

**Familiar collection bags and the current envelope
system remain in place.**
