DAY FOR LIFE 2022 is a day dedicated to raising awareness of the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition from the first moment of conception till natural death. This year's theme is 'Caring for the Older Person'. We invite people to think again about the value and worth of older persons in families and in society, and to make practical choices to build bridges between the generations. We call for people to devote quality time, energy and creativity in caring for the older persons in our communities. We encourage the provision of adequately resourced care of older persons so that no-one feels like a burden in our society. Pope Francis writes "The alliance between generations is our lost gift and we have to get it back. It must be found, in this throwaway culture."

[1] In 1223, he arranged for the first Christmas live nativity scene. [b][4] [5] Pope Gregory IX canonized him on 16 July 1228. Francis later became associated with patronage of animals and the natural environment. It became customary for churches to hold ceremonies blessing animals on his feast day of 4 October.
