



BUILDING HOPE

YOU MAY RECALL IN the spring of last year Archbishop Farrell established a Task Force, of which Fr Liam was a member, and launched a consultation process across the Diocese on the shape of the Diocese in the future.



Following the consultation process a report was issued. Archbishop Farrell has now issued a response to that report. In the document Archbishop Farrell looks at four key areas beginning with Pastoral Renewal across the diocese and our shared mission. He notes the serious issue of the shortage of ordained priests and if we are to have vibrant communities of faith in the future it will be the non-ordained laity who will have to shoulder the burden. This is our shared mission. The full document is available on our parish website on the Building Hope Tab on the home page as well across our social media platforms. Please take time to read it, it is not very long nor is it a difficult read, but it is very important.

Tap and Go Contactless Donation A choice as to how you donate The Archdiocese of Dublin has introduced a "Tap and Go" contactless donation method to enable people to donate directly to the First Collection (Common Fund Priest Collection) and the Second Collection (Share Fund



Card machines are in place at the back of the Church for this purpose.

Please note any donation through this method will be split 60% to the Common Fund & 40% to Share Fund You can use your Debit/Credit Card or indeed your mobile phone if you it payments enabled on your phone. Familiar collection bags and the current envelope system remain in place.
