



St Kieran Feast Day-Monday 6th March 2023

Ciarán of Saigir[[](5th century – c. 530), also known as Ciarán mac Luaigne or Saint Kieran was one of the <u>Twelve Apostles of Ireland^[2]</u> and is considered the first saint to have been born in Ireland,^[3]. Ciarán was <u>bishop</u> of <u>Saighir</u> (Seir-Kieran) of <u>diocese of</u> <u>Ossory</u>.He is sometimes called Saint Ciarán the Elder to distinguish him from the other 6th-century Irish <u>Saint</u> <u>Ciarán</u>, who was <u>abbot of Clonmacnoise</u>. He shares the feast date with his mother, St. Liadán

SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT-Sunday 5th March

"On his way to Jerusalem, where he will be crucified, Jesus is transfigured before three of his disciples. This manifestation of glory, says Thomas Aquinas, was designed to encourage the disciples during the difficult days that would follow. It gives hope to us too. On the sometimes painful journey through this life, we see in the Transfiguration of the Lord a sign of what awaits us: a glorified life with God."

POPE FRANCIS' commentary on last Sunday's gospel of Jesus' temptations are worthy of consideration:

"The three temptations [of Jesus in the desert] point to three paths that the world offers, promising great success, three paths to mislead us: GREED FOR POSSESSIONS - to have, have, have [look at the rampant materialism / consumerism of our time, undue self-reliance, apathy towards the poor]; HUMAN VAIN GLORY [self-centredness, the cult of celebrity, constantly seeking after the approval of others rather than God's approval]; THE EXPLOITATION OF GOD [presumption, thinking that God will aways do our bidding and guarantee our agendas, a loss of the sense-ofsin]. These are three paths that will lead us to ruin. These are the paths that are set before us, with the illusion that in this way one can obtain success and happiness. But in reality, they [the 3 ways of the world] are completely extraneous [unhelpful] to God's mode of action; rather, in fact they distance us from God... And he reveals the remedies to us: [having and developing] an interior [spiritual] life, faith [trust] in God, the certainty of his love – the certainly that God loves us, that he is Father, and with this certainty we will overcome every temptation."
