ECUMENICAL BIBLE WEEK

Following the Eucharistic Congress in 2012 some Catholic and Church of Ireland leaders thought it would be a good idea if there could be an initiative of common interest that we could share, on the principal that there is more that unites than divides us. And so Ecumenical Bible Week was born.

Ecumenical Bible Weeks runs from the Feast of Pentecost to the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity and is celebrated by all the major Christian denominations in the greater Dublin area. It is co-sponsored and funded by Archbishop Dermot Farrell and Archbishop Michael Jackson of the Church of Ireland. In preparation for Ecumenical Bible Week, we welcome the
