CATECHETICAL CORNER - SYNODALITY

Synodality is a way of being. It is about sharing our journey in faith together. It is about talking and listening and it is about arriving together to the Kingdom, hopefully not leaving anyone out. The concept of Synodality is not new in the Church. In fact we find the first syodal gathering in the Bible in the Book of the Acts of the Apostles, when the apostles and early leaders of the Church met to decide on an issue that had arisen – Acts 15. The concept of Synodality fell out of practice and was only revived quite recently. Up unit1 the current Synod, synods were only attended by the bishops of the Church, with perhaps some invited guests, such as theologians who were not bishops. However, what is different about this synod is that of the approximately 470 participants only some 300 are bishops the rest are either religious or lay faithful. All the participants are invited, none are there by right and many prominent Church voices have not been invited.

Last week at the Synod participants shared the first reports from the working group discussing Section A of the Instrumentum Laboris. The Instrumentim Laboris is the working document for the Synod. It was compiled from the responses from the National Synthesis Documents of the various countries. Among these reports were many themes that arose as distinctive signs of a synodal Church that emerged with greater clarity and need to be highlighted or deepened. Some of the key themes were: Accompaniment of Migrants, return to the essentials to an outgoing Church, the need to repair the Church – healing and accompanying; formation in seminaries and formation of all GOD's people and how to be a welcoming Church.

Synod Prayer

It is called the Adsusmus, which is the first words of the prayer in Latin:

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.

With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts;

Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality

influence our actions.

Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is

right.
All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever.

Amen.
