Help us to live our daily lives knowing that we share in Jesus' light and life. Forgive us for our shortcomings and draw us closer to You daily. Holy Mary, who said 'Yes' that we might have life, pray for us all. Amen. Light a candle, preferably a Red one as red is the colour of Christmas. It is an Irish tradition of lighting a candle as a sign of welcome. We welcome the Baby Jesus into our home. Pray the Hail Mary and other intentions
