1. WISDOM: helps us see the world differently and from God's point of view.

2. UNDERSTANDING: enables us to know more clearly the mysteries of faith.

3. COUNSEL [also known as Right Judgment]: helps us to discern what is right and what is wrong.

4. FORTITUDE (also known as Courage): strengthens our will so that we can actually accomplish what is true, good and beautiful.

5. KNOWLEDGE: enables us to discover God's will in all things.

**6. PIETY:** helps us to love God, our merciful Father, and to obey his precepts out of love for him.

7. FEAR OF THE LORD [also known as Wonder and Awe]: helps us to understand how we must depend on God for everything. In other words, he is God, we are not.

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Your Love. Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created and You shall renew the face of the earth.

### **WISDOM**

#### Come, Spirit of Wisdom.

We read in the Bible that King Solomon was offered anything that he would like from God, and he asked for the gift of Wisdom so that he could guide the people as God would like.

## RIGHT JUDGEMENT

#### Come Spirit of Right Judgement.

Right Judgment helps us to see things and people as God sees them and not as others see them. Jesus was always found in the company of the poor, of lepers and of other people who society thought were not good company and were shunned and excluded. Can you think of somebody that you might know who is excluded? How do you think God feels about them? And what do you think God would like you to do about it?



## **COURAGE**



#### Come, Spirit of Courage.

When we have the gift of Courage, the Holy Spirit, God's Spirit which lives in you, will help you to stand up for what you really believe in, even when it is not the popular thing to do. So if you really don't want to do it...say it!

But don't think that it will be easy just because you have the Holy Spirit on your side, you still have to decide what to do and what to say. Sometimes your friends might call you names, sometimes you might feel lonely and on your own but the right thing for you is always the best thing to do, no matter how difficult, this is why we have the gift of Courage.

### **KNOWLEDGE**

#### Come, Spirit of Knowledge.

Through the gift of Knowledge we come to know God in our hearts just like a daughter knows her father or a son knows his mother; or best friends know and love each other.
