Bambinelli Blessing



The beautiful Advent Tradition, Bambinelli Sunday, was instituted by Saint Pope John Paul II during his Papacy. The tradition follows that on Gaudete (*Rejoicing*) Sunday, the Third Sunday of Advent, children (and adults) bring their Baby Jesus figures from the crib to St. Peter's Square where the Pope will bless both the people and the figurines. We will celebrate "Bambinelli Sunday" <u>at all Masses this</u> <u>weekend</u>, Gaudete Sunday, 3rd Sunday of Advent. You are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figure from your home to Mass that weekend to be blessed. Families can even make their own "bambinelli" if they want. It is suggested that following the blessing, you take your "bambinelli" home and place it in a gift box, wrap it, and save it for Christmas morning. Let this be the first gift your family opens on Christmas, when together you place your Baby Jesus figure in the crib, and have a home blessing of the Nativity for your whole family.

CATECHETICAL CORNER - - "Reasons to be cheerful..."

In the late 1970's and early 1980's there was an English rock band called Ian Dury and the Blockheads who had a hit with a song called "Reasons to be Cheerful...". Although some of the reasons articulated in the song might not be appropriate for a Parish Newsletter, the theme is a good one. As we approach the end of Advent it might worth looking at the nature of Joy and our reasons to be cheerful or joyful.

Firstly, Joy is listed among the fruits of the Holy Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23). The fruits of the Holy Spirit are the evidence that the Holy Spirit is active in our lives. Joy, in the Christian sense, is not happiness or even a giddiness or good humour. Joy is more than a temporary happiness; joy is lasting and based in more than simply an emotional reaction to our circumstances: it is an active choice of attitude. As followers of Christ, we rejoice, because in him, we have redemption. The reasons for our Joy are, in line with the song, threefold, namely Christ's life, death and resurrection. As one Psalm says: "My lips will shout for joy as I sing your praise; my soul, too, which you have redeemed." – (Psalm 71:23)

When we consider our Blessed Mother we see that she too had this joy; "My soul magnifies the Lord, my spirit rejoices in GOD my saviour..." (Lk. 1:46-47). Christ Himself wanted us to have this Joy; "I have said these things to you so that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete." (Jn.15:11) What things are these that Jesus was saying? 'If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in HIS love. (Jn. 15:10) For Christians, our Joy is in the Lord, it says in another Psalm: "Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and shield. Our heart is glad in Him, because we trust in His holy name." (Ps: 33:22-23)

When the troubles of this world assail us, we can rest in the comfort that only God can bring, and have joy, no matter our circumstances. As we celebrate Gaudete (Rejoicing) Sunday let's take a moment or two to pray with the Entrance Antiphon of the Mass, *"Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near"*.
