Joachim a was, according to Sacred tradition, the husband of Saint Anne, the father of Mary (mother of Jesus), and the maternal grandfather of Jesus. The story of Joachim and Anne first appears in the Gospel of James, part of the New Testament apocrypha. Feast Day 26th July

St Ignatius of Loyola Saint Ignatius of Loyola was born in 1491 in Spain. He came from a noble family and grew up in a castle. As a young man, he dreamed of being a soldier and serving his king. He was brave and loved adventure.

In 1521, Ignatius was injured in a battle. His leg was badly hurt, and he had to stay in bed for many months. During this time, he read books about Jesus and the saints. These stories made him think about his life and his faith. He decided to follow Jesus and leave his old life behind.

He went on a pilgrimage to a shrine in Spain. He prayed a lot and spent time alone with God. He also wrote a book called the Spiritual Exercises. This book helps people grow closer to God through prayer and reflection. Many people still use this book today.

Later, Ignatius started a group called the Society of Jesus, also known as the Jesuits. They focused on education, missionary work, and helping the poor. He and the Jesuits worked hard to spread the message of Jesus. They made a big impact on the Church and the world. Ignatius died in 1556, but his legacy continues through the Jesuits and their work.

His Feast Day is 31st July


