PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

"The mission of the Church, the work of God, is not just the responsibility of the teaching Church, it is the call and the responsibility of all the baptised." So said Archbishop Farrell in the document launching the Diocesan Pastoral Council. The Archbishop continued: "One of the ways to ensure that the faithful are able to be heard and can participate in the life of the church, is through a ... Pastoral Council."

A Pastoral Council is not merely to assist the priests and Pastoral Workers in their work, but rather, to work alongside, collaborating as co-responsible equals, offering their time, talent and treasure for the good of our parishes. "Such a body allows the People of God to play a part in the pastoral development of the [parishes]."

The formation of a Pastoral Council is rooted in the call that

is issued to all of us at Baptism, the call to discipleship. It is rooted in the recognition that we are all gifted and graced by GOD in and through the Holy Spirit: "The Pastoral Council is a prayerful, discerning group of parishioners, representative of the partnership of parishes of Moone, Narraghmore & Athy. Seeking, in prayer, to discern how our parishes can interact with and respond to the context in which we, as faith communities, persist within the broader context of society. After a long period of discernment, prayer and discussion a combined Pastoral Council has been formed that will serve the people of the parishes of Narraghmore, Moone & Athy for a fixed 3-year term.

This new council will be commissioned at the 12noon Mass in St Michael's Church, Athy on Sunday,
September 21st.

St Pio of Pietreicina Feast Day 23rd September

St. Pio, born Francesco Forgione, was an Italian Capuchin friar known for his deep spirituality, stigmata, and miraculous works, becoming a beloved saint in the Catholic Church.

Born Francesco Forgione; 25 May 1887 – 23 September 1968), widely known as **Padre Pio**

(<u>Italian</u> for 'Father Pius'), <u>Latin</u>: *Pater Pius*, was an Italian <u>Capuchin</u> friar, <u>priest</u>, <u>stigmatist</u>, and <u>mystic</u>. He is venerated as a <u>saint</u> in the <u>Catholic Church</u>, on 23 September. Pio joined the Capuchins when he was fifteen and spent most of his religious life in the convent of <u>San Giovanni Rotondo</u>. He was marked by <u>stigmata</u> in 1918, leading to several investigations by the <u>Holy See</u>. Despite temporary sanctions

Despite temporary sanctions imposed by the Vatican, his reputation kept increasing during his life, attracting many followers to San Giovanni Rotondo. He was the founder of the Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza, a hospital built near the convent of San Giovanni Rotondo.

After his death, his devotion continued to spread among believers all over the world. He was beatified on 2 May 1999 and canonized on 16 June 2002 by Pope John Paul II.


