### CHURCH NOTICES

On 3<sup>rd</sup> May, the government announced the roadmap for reopening society and lifting Covid 19 restrictions.

According to these guidelines:-  
**All churches are closed until 20<sup>th</sup> July at least.** Phase 4, on 20<sup>th</sup> July states that "Places of worship can be opened with social distancing measures.

All those who had **baptisms or weddings** booked before this date have been contacted and these ceremonies have been postponed. Phase 5 on 10<sup>th</sup> August, will allow some larger social gatherings, such as weddings, to take place. These will be restricted to the risks involved.

All **First Holy Communion**s have been postponed until after the summer holidays. A letter from the Parish Team has been sent out through the schools. If you are a parent or guardian of a child who was due to receive their First Holy Communion and did not receive this email from the school, please contact your school.

**Funerals** The current restrictions will remain in place. Funerals, including those who died Covid 19 positive, can hold a funeral Mass in church. Attendance at funerals is kept to a maximum of 10 people-and only members of the household, close family or close friends. Social distancing and hand hygiene guidelines are adhered to. Phase Two which is on 8<sup>th</sup> June, will allow a slightly larger number of people to attend funerals. This number will be announced closer to 8<sup>th</sup> June. A moving tribute to the deceased is when extended family, neighbours and friends line the route respecting social distancing. This is such a show of support to the family of the deceased.

**The Parish Office is closed.** However you can contact the Parish Secretary by phoning the usual Parish Office number 059 86 38391 which is diverting to the Parish Secretary who is working from home. 
