Sunday Masses will 10.30 am and 12.30 pm. The later time of 12.30 pm is to allow sufficient time for cleaning and sanitising of the church. Mass in Barrowhouse is at 9 am.

Mass is celebrated every weekday at 9.30 am. Rosary will be prayed at 9 am in St. Michael's Church, Athy. Parish Church will be open until 5 pm every weekday.

## **Cemetery Masses**

It is with regret that it has been decided to cancel all cemetery Masses This summer. This is due to the current government guidelines on Covid-19 limiting outdoor gatherings to 200 people and also accepting the difficulty of social distancing of two meters, even in a cemetery. We hope to proceed with the usual November blessings of the graves subject to government guidelines.

## **Baptisms**
